



## Northeast Ohio Chapter 12 SAR

The Chapter meeting was held at Ferrante's Restaurant on November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at Ferrante's Restaurant in Harpersfield, Ohio.

- Compatriot Bailey asked all members present who served in the US Military to stand and be recognized, introduce themselves, and briefly talk about their military service.

#### Program:

Compatriot Terry Robinson provided a very interesting and informative talk about the US Military. He discussed and named various notable individuals who served in the US Military. His talk revolved around his perspective of military service as a Captain, Supply Corps, in the U.S. Navy a was Supply Officer in USS O'Hare(DD889) and an Inventory Manager /Rear Admiral's aide at Defense Electronics Supply Center in Dayton. Terry focused on the many and varied support jobs that are necessary for a military organization to run efficiently and effectively. Examples included cooks, laundry workers, Post Office workers, supply, inventory, Ship Store, and many other classifications necessary to support the functions of a military operation. He gave a number of interesting statistics about Naval operations not commonly known by the public things such as the number of navy ships in operation; number of meals served onboard ship, and laundry operations. It takes 2 years for a nuclear powered ship to refill and while at sea, cooks serve approximately 5,687 meals three times a day 7 days a week.
